What is the Program of Emphasis?

The National Program of Emphasis is the national annual event that is led by the national officers and planned by their peer section chiefs. The event may be a NOAC, Operation Arrow, NCOC or any other event. They are advised by selected capable adults.







The Program of Emphasis (cont.)

The Program of Emphasis isn't the same every year, it alternates from year to year. The Program of Emphasis is any one of the following:

- National Conference (NOAC)
- National Council of Chiefs (NCOC) Invite Only
- Operation Arrow at National Jamboree
- National Service Project

Programs of Emphasis



National Order of the Arrow Conference (NOAC)

The National Order of the Arrow Conference (NOAC) is the flagship national Order of the Arrow event. It is held every two years at a major university campus and is attended by as many as 8,000 Arrowmen from all 50 states. It is second only to the National Scout Jamboree in size and scope.

Operation Arrow

Operation Arrow is the OA's presence at the National Jamboree.

- Lodge Scholarship Opportunities




National Council of Chiefs (NCOC) or National Service Project

The National Council of Chiefs (NCOC) is a gathering of lodge and section leaders from across the nation aimed at providing an opportunity for the OA's youth leaders to provide input on the direction of the OA, make connections with Arrowmen they would not ordinarily have the opportunity to meet, and participate in a quality training program aimed at supporting their leadership role.

Opportunities for lodges to get involved can include:


- Keeping lodge members up to date on national updates
