# General Info

- All-volunteer team develops, secures and maintains the OA applications
- Budget from OA is very small - spent on hosting the applications
- Stats:
  - 89% of invited Arrowmen use the Member Portal
  - 228 Lodges are using the Member Portal today
  - At NOAC:
    - 98.8% of Delegates claimed their email (for Ascent, NOAC app, etc.)
    - 596 support tickets (so far!)

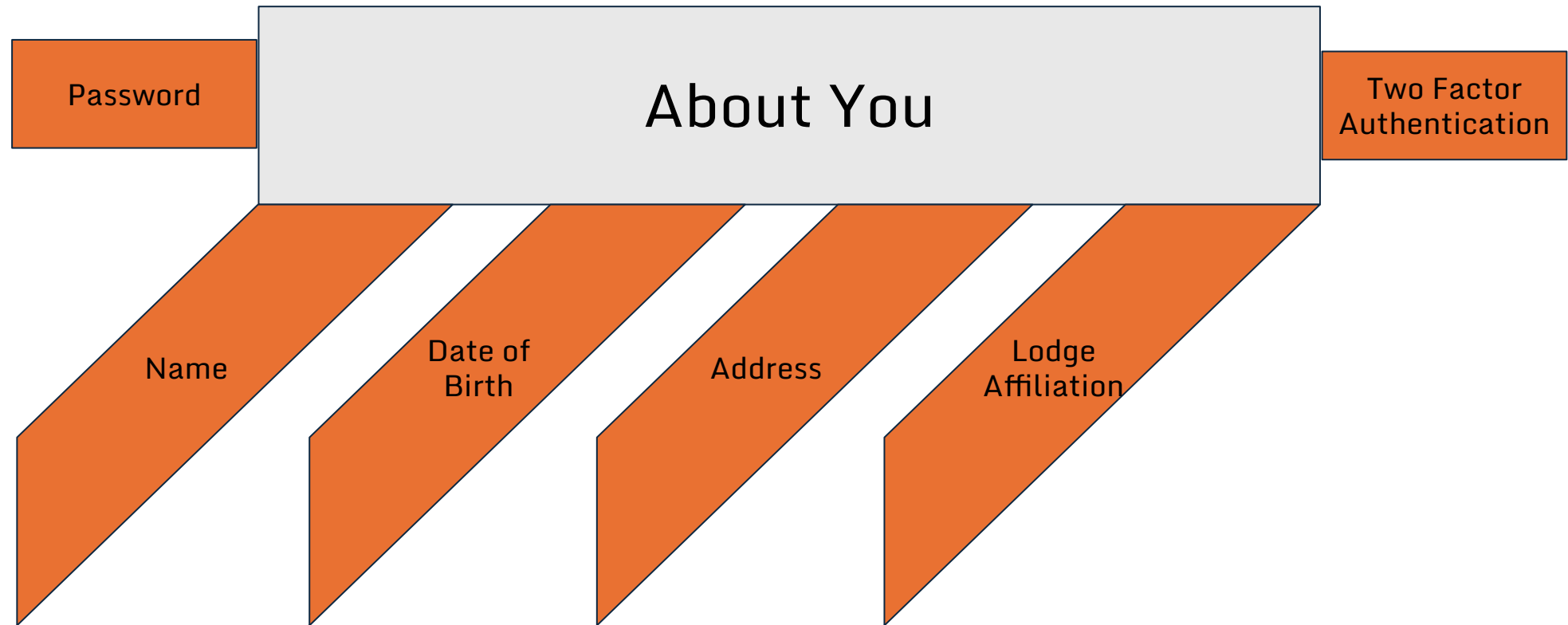

# Two-factor authentication - Why you should turn it on / How it helps

## Single Factor Authentication

**Look like:** Username + password

Advantages: Simple!

Disadvantages: Less secure

## Two Factor Authentication

**Look like:** Username, password + a rotating code (from your phone, usually)

Advantages: Much more secure

Disadvantages: Slightly less convenient

To Enable:

- 1) Log onto ArrowID (<https://id.oa-bsa.org>)
- 2) Edit Account
- 3) Two-factor Authentication → Setup
- 4) Setup Authenticator App

Configure authenticator app

To use an authenticator app go through the following steps:

1. Download a two-factor authenticator app. You can use any app, including:  
Microsoft Authenticator for [Android](#) and [iOS](#)  
Google Authenticator for [Android](#) and [iOS](#).
2. Scan the QR Code or enter this key `313x c12b g41s 1h1p 4x2o r22t 4gou awpc` into your two factor authenticator app. Spaces and casing do not matter.



3. Once you have scanned the QR code or input the key above, your two factor authentication app will provide you with a unique code. Enter the code in the confirmation box below.

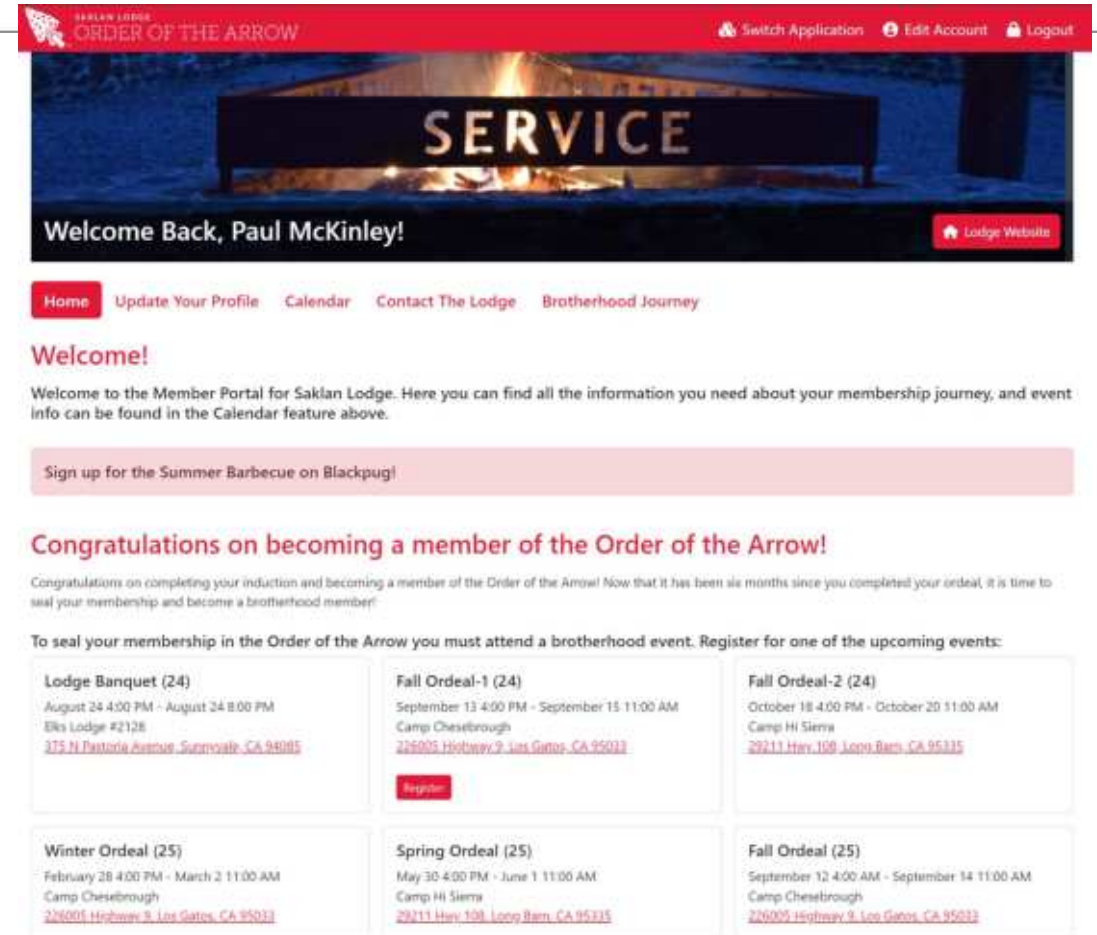

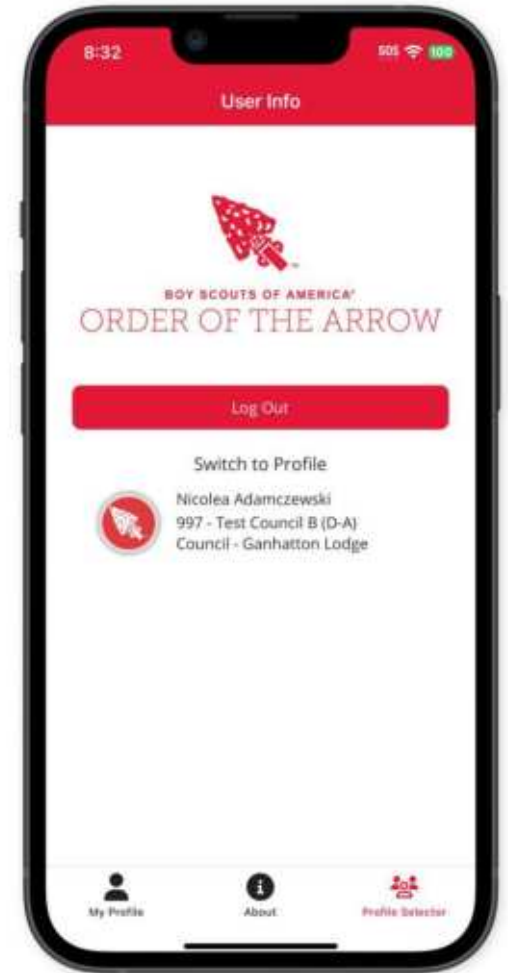
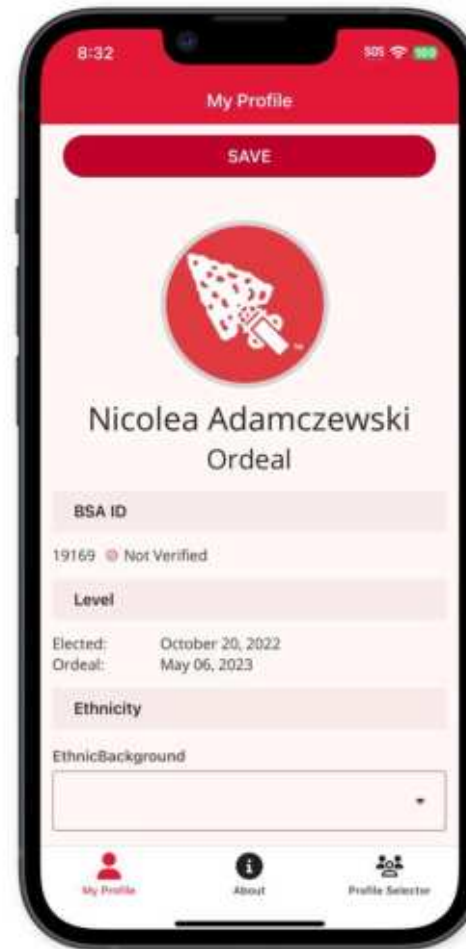

The Order of the Arrow (OA) is an honor society for Scouts who truly live by the Scout Oath and Law. By recognizing these Scouts, they inspire others to membership in the future. OA members all share certain Scout skills and help to promote camping within your unit. Members can grow in their leadership skills and further benefit your unit as they encourage a lifetime of cheerful service in other Scouts. All troops, crews, and ships with eligible Scouts should hold an election by [[LastElectionDate]]. You, as the unit leader, get to choose when and where the election will be held.

Custom Lodge Block 1

To be eligible for youth membership in the OA you must:

1. Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America
2. Be under 21, hold the Scouts BSA First Class rank or higher, and be elected by youth members of their unit
3. Have completed 15 nights of camping within 2 years, including 1 long-term camp of at least 5 nights and 10 nights of short-term camping. The balance of the camping (10 nights) must be overnight, weekend, or other short-term camps of, at most, three nights each. Ship nights meet the camping requirement for Sea Scouts.
4. Assistant scoutmasters 18-20 years old may also be eligible, so long as the above requirements are met.

Before your unit's election, the unit leader must affirm a nominee's Scout spirit and youth membership qualifications. Voting is based on the nominee's spirit of brotherhood, cheerfulness, and willingness to serve others.

The election should take place at a regular unit meeting or camping experience, with 100% attendance of both youth and adults. An election team from the OA will be present to conduct the election.

The Order of the Arrow is offering you an opportunity to join other Arrowmen in cheerful service and the formation of lasting brotherhood on the trails of Philmont Scout Ranch. Under the direction of the Philmont Conservation Department, experienced Philmont staff members with strong Order of the Arrow backgrounds will lead participants on a two-week trail crew and trek.

The program is a fourteen-day experience. The first week focuses on trail construction and maintenance under the guidance of Philmont trail crew foremen. The second week is a seven-day backpacking trek that is designed by the participants. The program is not simply building trail and hiking as it is ultimately a journey that challenges Scouts mentally, physically, and spiritually.

Trail building is tough. The worksite experience is full of long and strenuous days requiring a great deal of physical effort. Participants are expected to work with great diligence as the trail that is being built is designed to last over 75 years and protect the beautiful landscape of Philmont Scout Ranch. Other than trail-building techniques, Scouts will strengthen their leadership skills, learn advanced wilderness and low-impact camping skills, observe and participate in group wilderness safety, and experience motivation activities while also receiving special OA instruction. The program's mission is to maintain, reinforce, and enhance the purpose of the Order of the Arrow by using Scouting camping traditions. Participants are expected to use their experience to benefit their troop, chapter, lodge, and council programs.
