### Session Description

This session covers key aspects of interview preparation, including researching the company, understanding the job role, and practicing common interview questions. Learners will also learn about effective communication techniques, body language, and how to make a lasting positive impression on interviewers. Additionally, the session will address how to handle challenging questions and post-interview follow-ups. Ideal for job seekers, this session aims to boost confidence and improve interview performance, significantly increasing the chances of job success.
