Introduction: 3 minutes

Section 2: 10 minutes

<u>Say</u>let's review the mission and vision of our organization, highlighting the importance of how these guiding words encompass all that the program has to offer.

The OA Mission is "To achieve the mission of Scouting America through transformative fellowship that ignites limitless Scouting journeys."

Say: The Order of the Arrow is built on the foundation that Scouting America has built up for over 100 years. Knowing our role in the realization of this mission helps us understand that fellowship and service serve a deeper purpose in supporting the goals of Scouting America.

[Change Slide]

The mission of Scouting America is to "prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law."

Say: These guiding words share the scouting movement's impact, understanding this mission fuels the word of our order.

Say: Put these together, and the OA mission would read in full:

"To prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetime by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law through transformative fellowship that ignites limitless Scouting journeys."

Say: Phew, that's a lot! Let's break that down into chunks and highlight some of the key words in this mission.

[Change Slide]

Trainer Tip: Emphasize the following words bolded

- To **prepare** young people
- to make ethical and moral **choices** over their lifetime
- by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law
- through a transformative fellowship
- that ignites **limitless** Scouting **journeys**.

[Change Slide]

Say: Over the course of this training event, the goal is to gain a better understanding of the OA mission and how it plays out in the real world of your chapters, lodges, and beyond. In the end, we want you to walk away with a better understanding of how to prepare, what choices are at play, how Scouting values guide those choices, how transformative fellowship can be a way to prepare for those choices, and the limitless journeys that come out of that transformative fellowship.
